

Are you eligible to claim a VAT refund?

You are eligible for a VAT refund if:

- You normally live outside of the EU
- If you live outside of the EU and you are working / studying in the UK, you may still be eligible if you can prove you are leaving the EU for more than 12 months
- EU residents may also qualify if you leave the UK for a destination outside of the EU and do not return to the EU within 12 months.

In all cases you must:

- Be able to prove that you belong to one of the categories above by showing the customs official your passport, visa or other documents
- Take the goods outside of the EU by the end of the fourth calendar month after purchase (eg: goods bought on 1 or 31 January would have to be exported by 30 April).



Are you eligible to claim a VAT* refund?

If you live outside the European Union you can reclaim UK sales tax (VAT) for many things you buy while visiting Britain. The VAT rate is currently 20% so you could make substantial savings.

You can claim for anything you buy from a participating retailers which has VAT included in the price, **except** for the following:

- Services (eg hotel bills)+
- Goods bought online or by mail order
- Unmounted gemstones

- Consumable goods you've already started using
- Goods that need an export licence (except antiques)
- Goods worth over £600, being exported for business purposes
- Goods to be exported as freight.

How do I claim?

1Get a VAT refund form

When you purchase goods, inform the retailer immediately that you wish to reclaim VAT. The retailer will give you a VAT Refund Form to complete and sign.

2 Complete the form

Please ensure you complete the VAT Return Form (sample shown).

Go to Customs before Security

To reclaim VAT on goods that need to be packed into your check in baggage, go to Customs before Security. They will check and stamp your VAT Refund Form. To collect your refund visit a VAT refund desk.

4 Go to Customs **after** Security If you're claiming for jewellery or electrical items worth over £250 and the item can be placed in your hand luggage, you must visit Customs after Security, where they will check and stamp your VAT Refund Form. To collect your refund visit a VAT refund desk.

5 Collect your refund It depends on the kind of VAT form you've been given. Some only permit a refund to your credit card, or by cheque sent to your home. Others allow a cash refund (there may be a fee to pay), which can be paid in a different currency.
